All provisionally accepted authors will be asked to prepare their camera-ready manuscripts in accordance with the guidelines and to submit them until **22 June 2008**.

Papers accepted by the Programme Committee will be published in the workshop proceedings. A detailed programme of the workshop will be sent to the participants by **3 August 2008**.

VENUE OF THE WORKSHOP

The workshop will be held at the Faculty of Automatic Control, Electronics and Computer Science, which is part of the Silesian University of Technology, Gliwice, Poland. The campus is located within a walking distance from the town centre and the railway station.
