Papers accepted by the Programme Committee will be published in the workshop proceedings. A detailed programme of the workshop will be sent to the participants by **14 July 2006**.

LANGUAGE

The official language of the workshop is English

VENUE OF THE WORKSHOP

The workshop will be held at the Faculty of Automatic Control, Electronics and Computer Science, which is part of the Silesian University of Technology, Gliwice, Poland. The campus is located within a walking distance from the town centre and the railway station.
